

# THE "AT HOPE" 2017 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Rotary Club of Naperville is pleased to announce scholarship opportunities for high school seniors who are residents of the 203 or 204 School District attendance areas. The primary criteria for selection for the "At Hope" scholarship varies from the other three scholarships offered in that the "At Hope" Scholarship specifically recognizes and rewards the student's hopeful behavior in overcoming significant challenges during his/her high school career. How one chooses to navigate and emerge from overcoming various life's challenges, even at an early age, demonstrates the character of the individual, and the resolve to future success. In this case, the term "at-hope" is the reverse of "at-risk". This \$1,000 scholarship is for a high school senior who is able to demonstrate overcoming a challenge over the course of their high school career. One "At Hope" scholarship will be awarded for each of the five local high schools. Leadership qualities, school service, and community service are additional areas that may be taken into consideration for applicants. The \$1,000 scholarship is payable for one year only.

Completed applications are due April 22, 2017. Late applications will not be accepted.
